- 1 For accurate results, print at 100% scale

A credit card should fit in this box if printed to correct scale.

- 2 Cut out frames and hold up to your face to determine your best size range.
Tip: to get an accurate size, do not bend cutout

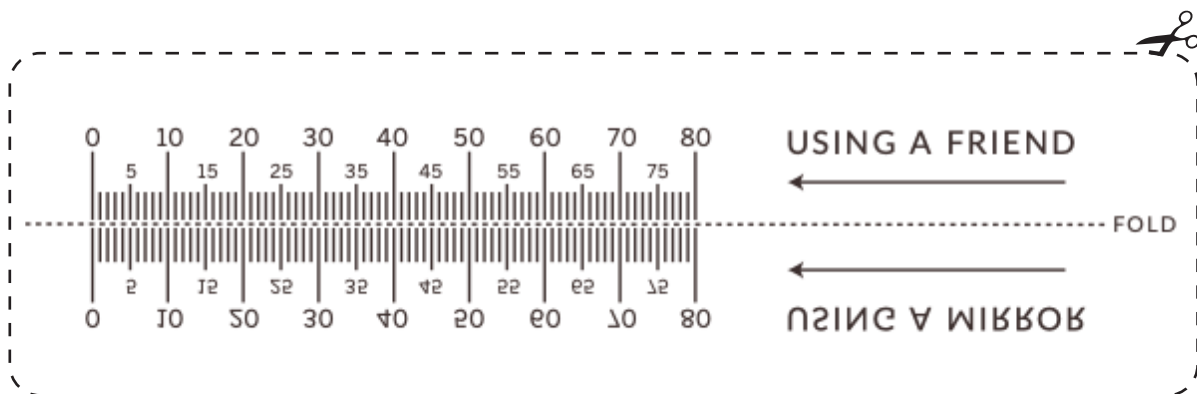
- 3 Once you know your size, visit [Zenni.com](https://www.zenni.com) and use the filter feature to narrow down your search by size.

If you don't know your PD, you can measure it with our digital PD tool by scanning the QR code, or you can use the PD ruler cutout below.

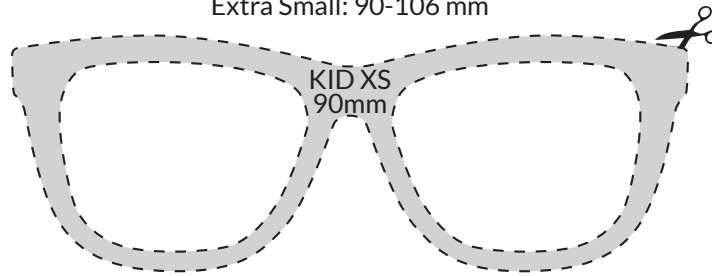

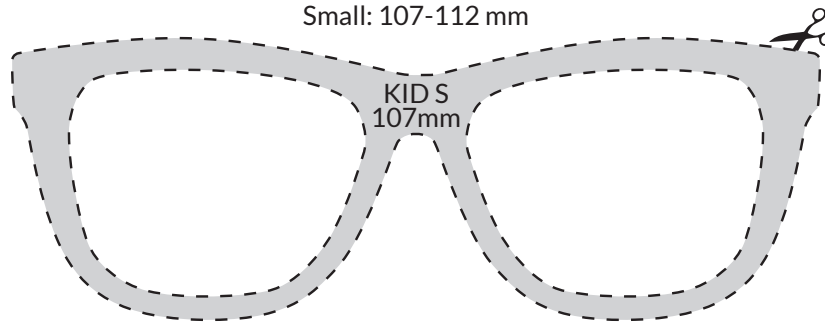

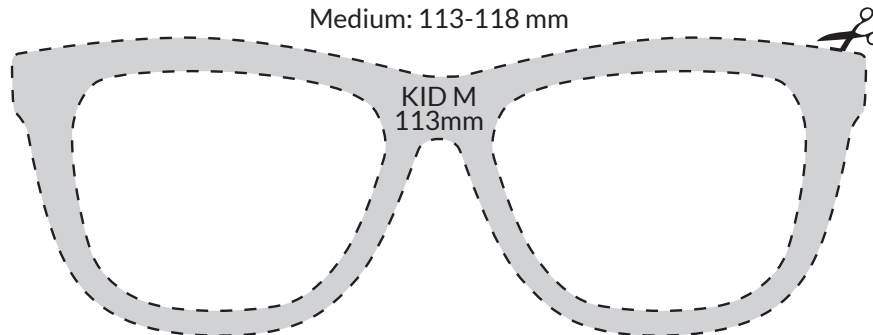

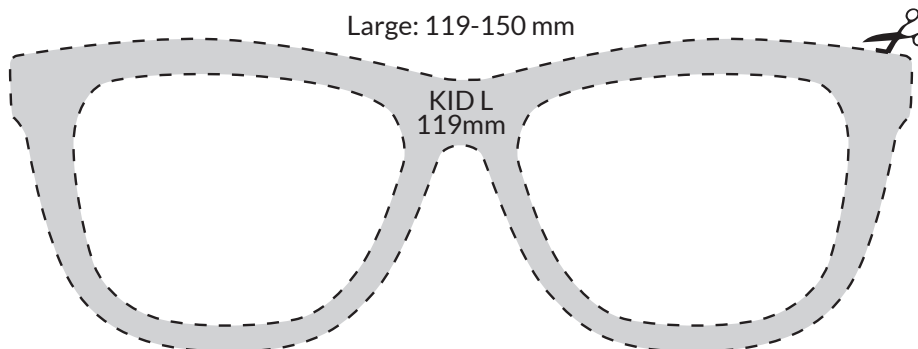

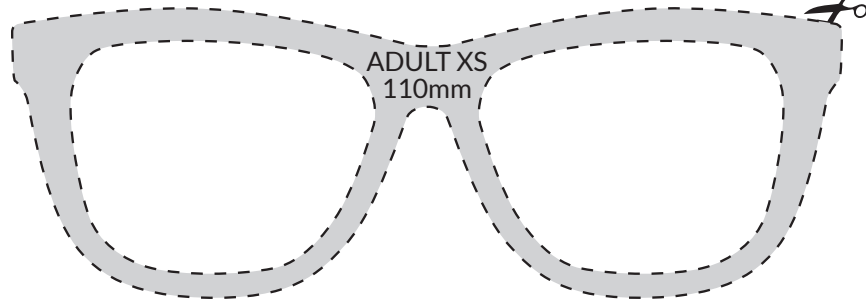

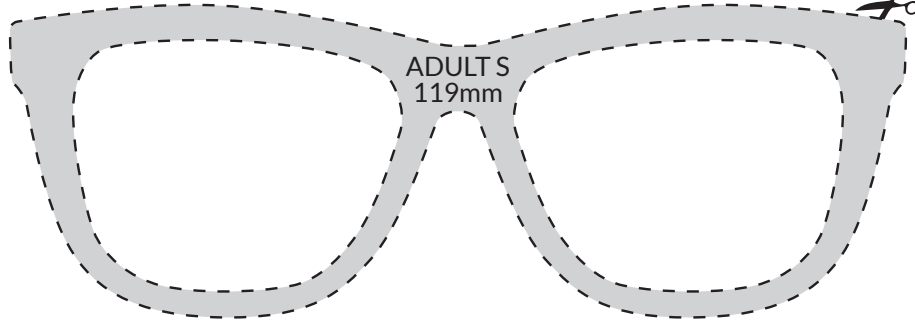

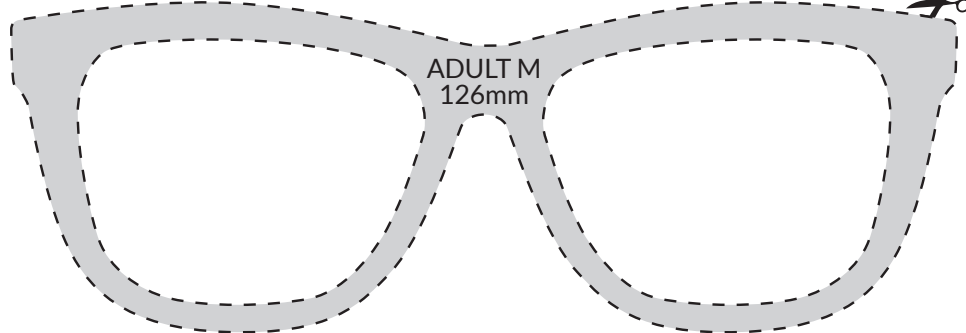
